To improve team work, all the members (lead by the team leader) should share honest feedback, practice, set and work towards a common goal and learn from each other's' failures and successes. There must be free flow of ideas that when assembled thoughtfully, are capable of producing quality work, through positive collaboration and mutual encouragement.

A team approach can therefore lead to faster, deeper innovation.


## **4. Teammates learn from each other**
